- 4/. **E CIGARETTES:** These are to be treated much the same as regular tobacco cigarettes and will not be tolerated on the premises.

STAGE SHOW

CONTESTANTS

All contestants must give their names to the person organising the show and sign this form this must be done before the competition starts. No person may just take to the stage without registration.

REFUSAL

The management reserves the right to refuse any person the right to enter the competition, the grounds may not necessarily be given, but entrants intoxicated or unsteady on their feet will be refused on the grounds of danger to themselves or others.

PRIZES

These will vary from time to time.

OWN RISK

All contestants enter the competition at their own risk no liability can be taken by the club for injury or loss or damage to their property.

DRINKING

No drinks are to be taken on to the stage at any time.

ACTS OF INDECENCY

Any act deemed indecent by the management will be directed to leave the stage immediately and disqualified from the competition.
